SB 272 ENTERPRISE SYSTEM CATALOG

SB 272 requires local agencies (excluding school districts) to create catalogs of all 'enterprise systems' that store information about the public, and to post this catalog on their websites, if they have websites. Governor Brown approved SB 272 in October 2015, adding section 6270.5 to the California Public Records Act (the "Act," Government Code Sections 6250-6276.48).

Section 6270.5 defines an 'enterprise system' as a software application or computer system that collects, stores, exchanges, and analyzes information that the agency uses that is:

- 1. a multi-departmental system **or** system that contains information collected about the public *and*
- 2. a system of record

A system of record means a system that serves as an original source of data within an agency. SB 272 requires local agencies to create a catalog of multi-departmental systems or systems containing information about the public that store original records and post the catalog on their agency website.

UMRWA does not have an enterprise system (or for that matter any data collection and storage system). Thus an UMRWA Enterprise Catalog neither exists nor is required.
